



## Mobile Mark, Inc. Compliance Statement Conflict Minerals

Mobile Mark, Inc. is aware of all environmental compliance legislation and laws. To the best of our knowledge and that of our suppliers we are in conformance with EU RoHS II Directive (2011/65/EU), REACH Regulation (EC 1907/2006), and Conflict Minerals: Dodd Frank Act Section 1502.

The Conflict Minerals Law is Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010. This law mandates supply chain traceability for publicly traded companies that use, make, or sell products with "Conflict Minerals" 3TGs (Tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold, and the ores from which they originate). The law requires companies to check their supply chains for tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold, if they might originate in Congo or its neighbors.

The most relevant materials covered under Conflict Minerals Law might be used for antenna products are electronic discrete products like tantalum capacitors. None of the antenna products that Mobile Mark designed has utilized any discrete tantalum capacitor components.

We will continue to include RoHS/EU Directive 2002/95/EC, EU RoHS II Directive (2011/65/EU), REACH Regulation (EC 1907/2006), and Conflict Minerals: Dodd Frank Act Section 1502 RoHS as a requirement for all our antennas, including new antenna designs added to our product line. Our commitment to our customers is that all the Mobile Mark antennas are compliant. We appreciate your business and look forward to continuing supplying you with our quality products.
